No. 1 Extra Light (CAN)

Grade A Medium Amber (USA)
No. 1 Light (CAN)

Grade A Dark Amber (USA)
No. 1 Medium (CAN)

Grade B or Grade A Extra Dark (USA)
No. 2 Amber (CAN)

Commercial Grade (USA)
No. 3 Dark (CAN)

Grade A Golden Color,
Delicate Taste

Grade A Amber Color,
Rich Taste
